



IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT KILLINGTON/PICO SHOP PROGRAM

Winter 2015-2016

Congratulations! Your Shop participates in the Killington Resort and Pico Mountain Marketing Partnership Program. Please read the following information carefully before heading to Killington or Pico to use the Shop Card.

- ◇ The Ski and Snowboard Shop Cards are to be used only by members of your staff who are working on a daily basis with ski and ride customers in your shop.
- ◇ Each Shop is issued two (2) shop cards. Each card will have your shop name on it and will be assigned specifically to your shop. PLEASE NOTE, WE **WILL** REACTIVATE LAST YEARS CARDS UPON RENEWAL, SO PLEASE DO NOT DISCARD THEM.
- ◇ Shop Cards are valid for Shop Employees only. They are **non-transferable**, may not be given or sold to any other individual, and Shop Employee spouses or dependents are not eligible for Shop Card privileges.
- ◇ The Shop Cards remain the property of Killington Resort. Shops who abuse these privileges, or who are not fulfilling the requirements of the program, will lose their privileges. Use of these privileges by individuals not entitled to them will result in a charge of theft of services.
- ◇ Shop Card privileges are valid Sunday through Friday beginning, Tuesday, December 1, 2015. Shop privileges are not valid on Saturdays and peak dates, 12/24/15 – 01/03/2016; 01/16-18/2016; 02/13-21/2016.
- ◇ With a Partnership Level Card, the shop employee will receive a FREE Killington 1-day lift ticket (also valid at Pico Mountain). With an Associate Level Card, the shop employee will receive 50% off that day's 1-day lift ticket rate. With a Pico Mountain Card, the shop employee will receive a FREE Pico Mountain 1-day lift ticket (not valid at Killington). Each card is valid for one ticket per day.

To redeem lift ticket upon arrival, Shop Employee can go to any ticket window and present:

1. A valid Killington Resort/Pico Mountain Shop Card. A Killington Shop Card is valid at Pico Mountain, but a Pico Mountain Shop Card is only valid at Pico Mountain.
2. Current pay stub or photocopy of current pay check (dated within last 14 days)
3. Valid Photo ID (driver's license)

Letters of introduction or business cards **will not be accepted** as a valid form of ID. It is the responsibility of the shop manager to communicate this information to all of his or her eligible employees. It is the responsibility of the employee to bring the required documents. **Lift tickets will not be issued without all three items listed above.**
